About INFLIBNET

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is an autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) located in the Infocity, Gandhinagar. Major activities and services of the Centre are geared towards modernization of academic libraries and information centres, promotion of information transfer and access, and support for scholarship, learning, and academic pursuits. The Centre acts as a nodal agency for networking of libraries and information centres in universities, institutions of higher learning, and R & D institutions in India. The Centre was established as an independent autonomous Inter-University Centre of the UGC in May 1996 and set out to be a major player for promoting scholarly communication among academicians and researchers across the country. With technology being a driving force in the contemporary education system, the INFLIBNET Centre has taken up a number of initiatives for the benefit of the academic community in India.

About

Providence Women's College (Autonomous), Kozhikode, managed by the Sisters of the Apostolic Carmel Congregation, was established in 1952 as the first women's college in the Malabar region and has grown into one of the largest women's higher education institutions in Kerala. Guided by its vision of holistic development rooted in the values of justice, love, and peace, the college offers FYUG, FYIP, postgraduate, integrated, and research programmes across 18 undergraduate, 6 postgraduate, and one integrated programme, supported by six recognized research centres and a vibrant academic community of about 2000 students. Initially affiliated with the University of Madras and later with Kerala University and the University of Calicut, the institution now functions autonomously, having been conferred Autonomous status by the UGC in 2024. The college has completed four NAAC accreditation cycles and currently holds an A++ grade with a CGPA of 3.65, along with recognition as a College with Potential for Excellence by the UGC and as a DBT Star College, as it advances confidently toward its 75th year of excellence in women's education.
