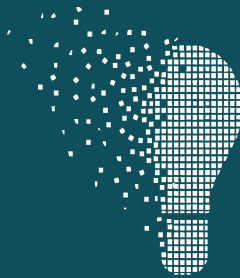

About INFLIBNET

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is an autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) located in the Infocity, Gandhinagar. Major activities and services of the Centre are geared towards modernization of academic libraries and information centres, promotion of information transfer and access, support scholarship, learning and academic pursuits. The Centre acts as a nodal agency for networking of libraries and information centres in universities, institutions of higher learning and R & D institutions in India. The Centre was established as an independent autonomous Inter-University Centre of the UGC in May 1996 and set out to be a major player for promoting scholarly communication among academicians and researchers across the country. With technology being a driving force in the contemporary education system, the INFLIBNET Centre has taken up a number of initiatives for the benefit of the academic community in India.

About Mizoram University

Mizoram University was created by an Act of Parliament (No. 8 of 2000) and became functional on July 2, 2001. The university is located in Aizawl, the capital city of Mizoram, and is spread over 978.1988 acres on the outskirts of the city. Prior to the existence of Mizoram University, the North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU), with headquarters at Shillong, operated a campus in Mizoram.

Presently, there are 40 academic departments under 10 schools, along with one constituent college (Pachhunga University College) and 40 affiliated colleges. There are a total of 260 teaching faculty and 366 non-teaching staff at the university. The university is eco-friendly and one of the country's first universities to run effectively on solar power systems. It provides facilities for disabled and visually challenged students and staff. All buildings on the university campus have ramps for wheelchairs, and disabled-friendly washrooms are also available in the hostels. So far, Mizoram University has made considerable progress in terms of infrastructure, academic programmes, manpower, and support services. The university is accredited an 'A' grade from NAAC and is ranked 76th in the NIRF ranking for 2023.
